

## SEF Awards Fall 2018 Grants

The Summit Education Foundation is pleased to announce our grant awards for the 2018 fall grant cycle. With generous support from our member families, the Foundation was able to approve funding for 56 grants, totaling over \$257,000. The District, Primary-Elementary, Middle and High School levels received grants totaling \$32,081, \$83,858, \$128,114, and \$13,311 respectively.

A sampling of approved grants includes:

- Headsets to increase opportunities to speak in the target language for all World Language students at Summit High School, \$1,998
