- Earbuds

– large letter locks do not fit!
- 2 boxes tissues (Homeroom)
- 1 pencil case
- 1 pk. #2 pencils
- 1 pk. multi-colored highlighters
- 1 pk. mixed colors ball-point pens
- 2 of each - Dark blue and black ink pens
- 1 roll “Scotch Tape”
- 2 pks. lined, punched notebook paper
- 1 pk. 3” x 5” lined index cards

GRADE 6

- 1 heavy-duty 2” 3-ring binder
- 1 Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS calculator
